## **Annual Report 2020-21**

Amal Public School running under Amal Charitable Trust led by its Chairman Mr. M.M. Abdul Azeez has crossed its 11<sup>th</sup> year of growth.

Our school comprises 38 teaching and 29 non-teaching staff. There are 589 students from Montessori to class X. Amal Montessori is one of the attractive faces of our school, comprising 99 students and 8 teachers.

### **Office System**

Effective communication with parents.

Smart class facility is made effective with regular rectification of shortcomings in time. Teachers were given time to time training for the same.

### **Academics**

This year we have shifted our classes to online platforms due to Covid -19 Pandemic. Classes are being conducted through MS Teams App.

Monthly interaction with parents through online media. Individual coaching to children of Montessori – II Std.

Unit Tests, Periodic Tests, Half Yearly and Annual Exams have been conducted under video monitoring.

In addition to these exams, Revision Tests and pre board exams were conducted for X Std children.

After the Lockdown is lifted, Note book checking and Open House were conducted classwise.

Children are being given individual personal attention with special care for slow learners. Remedial coaching is being given prior to termly exams.

Adoption method is implemented for students of classes VIII- X to ensure personal attention of children through which teachers keep a regular & constant contact with their adopted children as well as parents.

Weekly interaction of adopted children with their adoption teachers over phone.

Keeping a student diary of these children, teachers can go through their academic as well as behavioral issues.

Parental care, counseling & constant monitoring of these children are ensured.

Subject council for teachers in each term to ensure quality of teaching.

Termly assessment and evaluation of teachers are being done.

Support of special educator Mrs. Anu Alias and Student Counselor Mrs. Najeeba Thasnim is being given to students having learning and behavioural issues.

The following teachers are given charge as Head Teachers of the under mentioned sections so as to make monitoring more effective.

IX – X Classes are under the direct monitoring of Principal & Vice Principal.

Art and Craft classes also conducted through online media.
